ACC Update

The procedure for Covenant and [Design Standard](#) violations is as follows:

- You will receive a Certified letter listing the violations and notification of fining procedures.
- You will have 30 days from receipt to rectify the situation.

Please realize that we have taken the mailing and wording under the advisement of our attorney. The procedure used to take 60-70 days before the association could take action if the violation was not rectified. This new process (Jan, 2001) shortens the entire length to 30-40 days. Unfortunately, the actions of a few dictate the manner in which we have to respond. This method of notification is sent to all homeowners, not just habitual violators. As per our legal advisement, we must be consistent for all violations. *The violation letter is not meant to be offensive or threatening, but must adhere to legal standards.* If you have any questions or concerns, please contact an ACC member.

Because the pool area has been left a mess after parties already this summer, please be advised that the following is the process for pool parties:

Pool Party Procedures

- *Call & reserve with Swim Committee (Joe Perniciaro; 770-889-4625)*
- *Please call 7 days prior to party date.*
- *Pay \$150 refundable damage deposit.*
- *15 guest limit.*

You may reserve the pool on Monday through Thursday, for a 3 hour time limit, with the latest reservation being 6:30pm-9:30pm. The Gran Forest homeowner must be present for the entire time of the party.

- **LET'S STAY AHEAD OF THE RED ANTS AND WASPS THIS YEAR.**
Food containers, soda cans and juice boxes are a magnet for those biting critters and can make life miserable at the pool.
- **If you fill up the pool trashcan,** please take the time to empty it in the large Greenworks can at the side of the club house.
- We have a maid service that cleans the bathrooms Monday, Wednesday and Friday.
