All about the ACC

Remember that exterior changes to your home or lot need to be approved by the ACC, which usually meets the beginning of each month. These changes include any changes in color of your home and removing trees that are greater than 6 inches in diameter. Often, the request must be submitted on a plat. The approval process is allowed to take up to 30 days, so allow this time in your plans.

Water Ban

Effective immediately, no outdoor watering is permitted on Mondays, Thursdays and Fridays.

Even-numbered addresses (house numbers ending with the number 0, 2, 4, 6, 8 or no house number): Outdoor water use is allowed on Wednesdays and Saturdays.

Odd-numbered addresses (house numbers ending with the number 1, 3, 5, 7 or 9): Outdoor water use is allowed on Tuesdays and Sundays.

On appropriate days, outdoor watering may only occur between the hours of midnight and 4:00 a.m. and between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and midnight.

One day of outdoor watering was removed from each of the two address categories and added to Friday as non-watering days. To stay in alignment with the state-mandated regulations regarding odd and even addresses and to help make these changes as simple as possible, no swapping of days between even and odd addresses occurred. Reducing each address category by one watering day was determined to be the best solution. Enforcement of the outdoor water restrictions will be increased. Violators are subject to citation, which can result in a fine of up to \$1,000. For updated info go to www.forsythco.com.
