OUR POOL RULES!

We have had an incident or two this swim season so here are a few reminders for the safety and comfort of all homeowners: <u>PLEASE</u>

- 1) Reminder: No one under 18 in the pool area after dark unless with an adult homeowner. This does not mean if you are 16 you can come with your 18 year old friends.
- 2) No Glass
- 3) No Balloons They will ruin the pumps.
- 4) Parties at the pool require no approval but please notify a board member so we know who is using the pool and when.
- 5) Please place all garbage in the garbage cans. We do not have a service to clean the tables and surrounding areas. This includes the tennis courts. (If the small can on the courts is more than 1/2 full please empty it in the garbage cans next to the pool.)
- 6) Please make sure you have all your toys, towels, etc. when you leave the pool.
