All about the ACC

The recent hail storms have created a surge in roof replacements in Gran Forest. If you are replacing your roof please adhere to theses guidelines:

Any change in color or shingle style must be approved by the Architectural Control Committee prior to start of work.

Fiberglass/asphalt shingles are the only approved material (no metal or tile).

Standard three tab or architectural styles are acceptable. Suitable colors are grays, browns or black.

Change requests should be submitted in writing to Access Management using the Gran Forest HOA Modification Request Form. This form is available at http://www.granforest.com/dnn/. Click the Homeowners link, and then click on Documents.
